3.2 Basis of the Assessment

The environmental effects of the Wednesbury to Brierley Hill scheme have been predicted for each relevant environmental topic (eg landscape, noise, cultural heritage etc) by comparing the baseline environmental conditions (ie the situation without the proposed scheme) with the conditions that would prevail were the scheme to be constructed and operated.

The environmental effects of the scheme are predicted in relation to environmental receptors, including:

- **people**, for example, residents of buildings and users of facilities etc;
- **built resources**, for example, a listed building; and
- **natural resources**, for example, a site of ecological interest.

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
