## F1.3 Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council SMR

### F1.3.1 Scheduled Ancient Monuments

#### General

The following Scheduled Ancient Monuments (SAMs) were identified:

- Dudley Castle, Medieval Castle at SO 945 907.

#### Dudley Castle

The castle was constructed in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. There is an oblong keep with semi-circular towers built of limestone faced reddish sandstone. The 14<sup>th</sup> century barbican with curtain walls also survives. There is a 16<sup>th</sup> century hall with the remains of 8 light transomed mullions and a Chapel with undercroft. Remains of minor adjuncts, kitchens etc on opposite side of upper bailey. The castle was inhabited until 1750, when destroyed by fire.

### F1.3.2 Listed Buildings

The following listed buildings, described in *Table F1.3* below have been identified in the vicinity of the proposed alignment. Detailed descriptions of Grade II and II\* listed buildings are also provided below.

## 7 Castle Hill. Grade II Listed

EC19. Small octagonal former lodge built of uncoursed limestone with rubble quoins to angles; 2 storeys; small casement windows with restored pointed lights; plain doorway with cornice hood on brackets; octagonal slate roof. Rectangular bay and modern additions on east side.

## Castle Hill, Dudley Zoo, Bentley's Wine Bar. Grade II Listed

Long, single-storeyed building with concrete framing, columns etc to front. 3 large window and one to each return with timber mullions and transoms. 4 entrances with side lights. South extension containing lavatories. Formerly listed as "Flamingo Restaurant at Dudley Zoo"

## Castle Hill, Dudley Zoo Entrance. Grade II\* Listed

Row of 5 gates with simple ticket offices of blue engineering brick under a series of stepped 'S' shaped canopies on circular metal supports. Plain return walls of blue brick at either side.

## Castle Hill. Former Odeon Cinema. Grade II Listed

An Oscar Deutsch structure built in 1937 for his chain of Odeon cinemas. Closed 1975, and purchased by the Jehovah's Witnesses as a Kingdom Hall in 1976.

## 6, 7 and 7a The Broadway. Grade II Listed

19<sup>th</sup> century red brick terraced cottage range. Red brick; 2 storeys.

## Birmingham St. St Edmund's School. Grade II Listed

Mid 19<sup>th</sup> century. 2 storey with basement and attick, built of coursed freestone.

## Castle Hill, former Conservative Club. Grade II Listed

Mid 18<sup>th</sup> century 3 storey house built of red brick.

## Castle St. Statue of Lord Dudley. Grade II Listed

Statue of Sicilian marble unveiled by the Countess of Dudley in April 1888.

## Castle St. St Edmund's Church. Grade B Listed

Red brick church constructed in circa. 1724. Building retains C18 pews, pulpit and panelled gallery.
