Significance is deemed to attach to any effect that clearly results in more than local loss of biodiversity, or any effect that involves the loss of irreplaceable habitat, especially ancient countryside.

High importance attaches to sites and areas having designation by reason of their importance for the maintenance of biodiversity. None of the recognised categories and designations (such as Biosphere Reserves under the UNESCO Man and Biosphere Programme or Sites on the Natural List of the World Heritage Convention under the Convention Concerning the Protection of the World's Cultural and Natural Heritage 1972 etc) are relevant to this assessment.
